



# GRADING THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Strive HI digs into the performances of Hawai'i's schools, and ranks them.

**F**or more than a decade, HONOLULU Magazine has been publishing a chart that ranks Hawai'i's public schools from best to worst. We started with official state Department of Education data—math and reading scores, and satisfaction surveys—and then did our own number crunching to arrive at an overall score for each school. It was a bit unorthodox, but we felt it provided valuable snapshot comparisons of the performances of different schools, that were unavailable anywhere else. Readers agreed—the schools chart has become one of our most popular annual pieces.

In 2013, the state DOE unveiled a new program called Strive HI. It's a tool to assess the performance of schools by collecting academic measures such as math and reading scores, as well as attendance and graduation rates and

other important criteria, and crunching them all together to arrive at an overall score for each school. It's information that's helpful for anyone with an interest in the quality of Hawai'i's public-school system. And after examining the data that went into this new official ranking, we've decided it's solid enough to publish in place of our old methodology.

Because we don't have the space to print every performance measure that went into each school's score, we selected the ones we thought families and taxpayers would be most interested in, including math, science and reading scores and graduation rates. The overall score for each school still incorporates the complete list of measures, of course—to see a detailed, full performance report for an individual school, visit [hawaiipublicschools.org](http://hawaiipublicschools.org) and click on the link in the center of the

page for "Strive HI System."

To make it easier to compare schools in an apples-to-apples way, we've divided the list into three sections: elementary, middle and high schools. Also, because raw number scores can sometimes be a little unwieldy, we've taken the liberty of giving each school a report-card-style letter grade, A through F, based on a curve. This isn't an official grade handed out by the DOE, but we think it's a useful shorthand when discussing how well a school is performing according to the Strive HI metrics.

Also in this issue, writer Loren Moreno takes a look at how the new teacher-evaluation program is panning out, and we speak with some of Hawai'i's top teachers to get their advice on how to improve our public education system (page 57).

## A Guide to the Chart

Elementary School Middle School High School

**1 RANK:** This list ranks public schools by their overall Strive HI index scores, with separate rankings for elementary schools, middle schools and high schools.

**3 DISTRICT:** The statewide school system is divided into seven administrative districts, including O'ahu's HONolulu, CENTral, LEEward and WINdward districts; the Big Island's HAWai'i district; Maui, Moloka'i and Lāna'i's MAUI district; and the KAUa'i district. CHArter schools are also included.

**4 STRIVE HI DESIGNATION:** Indicates the level at which the state Department of Education has classified a school: Recognition, Continuous Improvement, Focus or Priority.

**5 TITLE 1:** Indicating, Yes or No, whether the school was a Title I school in 2013–14, meaning

at least 40 percent of a school's students were from low-income families, as defined by the federal government.

**6 MATH:** The percentage of students enrolled the full school year who scored proficient or higher on the Hawai'i State Assessment in math. When fewer than 30 students were tested, data was pooled from multiple years to achieve an appropriate n-size.

**7 READING:** Percentage of students enrolled the full school year who scored proficient or higher on the Hawai'i State Assessment in reading. When fewer than 30 students were tested, data was pooled from multiple years to achieve an appropriate n-size.

**8 SCIENCE:** Percentage of students enrolled the full school year who scored proficient or higher on the Hawai'i State Assessment in science. For some schools this value is adjusted for a low-participation penalty.

**9 GAP RATE:** This number measures the achievement gap between high-needs students and non-high-needs students for 2013–14, by comparing the percentage of each group of students who scored proficient or above in math and reading. A smaller percentage point spread is better.

**10 UNIQUE:** Each of the school levels' scores, elementary, middle and high school, includes its own unique metrics. In this column, we chose a different one for each level:

**CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM RATE (ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS):** Indicates the percentage of students enrolled for the full school year who missed 15 or more days of school.

**EXPLORE SCORE (MIDDLE SCHOOLS):** Indicates the percentage of a school's eighth-grade students who scored at or above a 15 on the composite score of the EXPLORE version of the ACT.

**GRADUATION RATE (HIGH SCHOOLS):** Indicates the percentage of a school's students who graduated on time in 2013. For schools with 40 or fewer students, data may have been pooled.

**11 AND 12 FINAL SCORE (2013 AND 2014):** The school's overall index score according to the DOE, out of 400 points.

**13 GRADE:** A letter grade assigned by HONOLULU Magazine, based on a standard curve using the DOE index scores.

**N/A:** Indicates that data is not available, usually because the DOE has redacted results from small classes/schools for privacy reasons.
